Minutes from previous meeting moved to approve by Kim Parham, seconded by Alexis Maldonado

Kim Parham moved to adjust the 8.3 (Maximum Tenure: the maximum tenure for Officers shall be two(2) years.) to say "Officer Terms: the term for officers shall be two (2) years, with no more than two (2) consecutive terms served." – Seconded by Noelle Brigman, approved by consensus.
